
#1. At the end of his vision in verse 28 Daniel is "greatly alarmed." What is happening in the world today or in these apocalyptic visions that alarms you?

#2. As a Christian, how do you find comfort in the reality God is in control? BYOV Bring your own verse that reminds you God is on his throne and is sovereign over the events of men on earth!

#3. BYOV Look up some of the 81 times the title "Son of Man" is used to describe Jesus in the gospels. Bring your own verse to your fellowship group this week. What does this verse teach you about Jesus?

#4. **Read Romans 5:17-21.** You can also watch the Scripture of the Day video on this chapter called The Romans Road! Make a list of contrasts between Adam and the one true man in Jesus Christ. Why is it so important for you and everyone you know to have faith in Jesus?

#5. When it comes to eschatology (the study of the end times) a lot of people focus on "when" but the emphasis of Scripture is on "who". Do you live like Jesus is coming soon or like the world is just going to continue as it is?
